FISCAL COURT/TREASURER BILLS APPROVED

Open Invoice Reports from the Judge/Executive's Office dated through October 2, 2018 had been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval and copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office. Disbursements from each fund totaled: #01- \$ 25,1328.48; #02- \$ 22,172.91; #03- \$ 63,239.34; #04-\$ 51,399.42; #09- \$ 139,143.49; #77- \$ 2,018.54. Grand total disbursements from all funds: \$ 529,302.18.

Open Invoice Reports from the Treasurer's Office dated through September 27, 2018 had been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval and copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office. Disbursements from each fund totaled: #00- \$ 20,686.65; #01- \$ 78,954.50; #02- \$ 36,638.96; #03- \$ 86,605.30; #09- \$ 102,684.54. Grand total disbursements from all funds: \$ 325,569.95.

ROAD DEPARTMENT
GRADING ROADS

MOUNT ELMIRA ROAD
ROAD UPDATE

There has been fence put up that is not allowing traffic to pass through. There is another entrance, but the road is in rough shape. County Attorney John Wooldridge stated that some of those plats have been dedicated as public use, so he will look into the matter.

BULLITT COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE
STORAGE SPACE

Sheriff Donnie Tinnell asked Fiscal Court about available space upstairs that he could possibly use for property holding. He stated that he is over run with property and no place to put it. Magistrate Mitchell stated that he does not have a problem with this. Magistrate Laswell said to let him get with Mark, Maintenance Supervisor, to see which space is going to work best.

Jailer Martha Knox gave an update on the Tilt Skillet purchase. She stated that they have agreed to accept payment in December for the equipment. She also stated that their phone system is beginning to fall apart and will need to be updated soon.

Some candidates were present and introduced themselves at the meeting. These candidates included Jerry Summers, Tony Thompson, Mike Higgins, and Martha Knox.


ADJOURNMENT
